Welcome to the Southern Alberta Star Party, at Whispering Pines Camp, Elkwater, AB, in the spectacular Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park.

This Dark-Sky Preserve location was selected for its Bortle 2 sky and fantastic amenities. The camp has ample room for tents and RVs, and twelve cabins with heating and lighting, most with two rooms that can sleep up to six people. Washrooms and showers are available in the main building and in an auxiliary shower block.



Power is limited in the field, but every cabin has an external 15-amp outlet, so bring an extension cord and set up close to a cabin if you need electricity.



The main building also features a very spacious auditorium with audio-visual equipment, a games room, laundry facilities (detergent not provided), and a fully-equipped communal kitchen and dining area for guest use.





Mattresses for the cabin bunks are provided, but guests should bring their own pillows and bedding.

Less than 2km away is Elkwater town, which currently has one general store and two restaurants.


